On p. 5 I list only the recurring terms, with column numbers on the left and verse numbers in parentheses on the right. Concluding observations appear on p. 6. Verse 11b contains a prolepsis looking forward out of sequence to the end of the little horn. I do not treat this as a separate column because it is still part of one exposition section down through vs. 12. Columns 2-5 are all explanation.

Concluding observations: For whatever reason, Row A has 2 columns, row B has 3, row C has 4 columns, row B' has 2 columns, and row A' has 1 column, matching not a column but row 1. The pattern involving columns is chiastic (2 3 4 2 1). I regard the final row as extrametrical in the sense that structurally it doesn't correspond to anything else on the page.
