


Fig. 1. Five major prophetic time periods drawn to approximate scale, where the 1290 days and 1335 days are taken together with the rest.

By oversight I failed to have the following graphic with me at the prophecy symposium in Grayling, MI, when I gave my second presentation on August 9. See fig. 1.




Fig. 2. Five major prophetic time periods drawn to approximate scale, where the 1290 days and 1335 days are separated from the other periods and interpreted using literal rather than prophetic time.
